OVERVIEW:

In partnership with Cedar Crest Golf Course, Trinity Forest Golf Club will host the **2nd Annual Dallas Amateur Championship**, a 36-hole medal-play golf tournament on July 27 and 28, 2019. Net proceeds from the Dallas Amateur Championship (DAC) will benefit the **I Am A Golfer Foundation**, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.

Entrants must qualify for the championship at Trinity Forest by playing in an 18-hole qualifier at Cedar Crest on either May 31st, June 9th, June 22th, June 30th or July 6th. The event is open to anyone 22 years of age and older who does not currently compete on a college or junior college team. Participants can choose to compete in one of five divisions: Men's Gross, Men's Net, Men's Senior Gross (55+), Women's Gross, and Women's Senior Gross (55+).

ELIGIBILITY:

Amateur golfers ages 22 years of age and older. Amateur must also have a current certified USGA handicap. Amateurs can NOT currently compete on a college or junior college team.

EXEMPT PLAYERS:

The following categories of players are exempt, and a spot will be reserved for them in the Championship provided they complete the entry process (including payment) by June 15, 2019.

- First place winners from each division in the 2018 DAC

Priority will be given to exempt players in the order they are received up until the exempt player entry deadline. NOTE: *Exempt players may submit entry forms after the priority deadline has passed and will be processed on a first come first served basis on a space available basis.*

ENTRIES:

Players can register online at www.iamagolfer.com. Electronic payments will be required at the time of entry. Once on the site, players can choose which qualifier he/she will like to compete in. Each qualifier is limited to a field of 120 players.

WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS:

In the event of withdrawal prior to the entry deadline, entry fees will be refunded, but subject to a \$25.00 administrative fee. In the event of a withdrawal after the entry deadline, entry fees will be refunded, but subject to a \$50.00 administrative fee. No refunds will be made once the competition has begun. Refunds must be requested online through the DAC registration portal.

Entries are subject to the disqualification at any time, including during play. The reason for disqualification may include false statement of handicap index, improper attire and/or unbecoming conduct. Any person whose entry is accepted shall be subject to the "Rules and Conditions of Competition", as set by the committee and USGA.

FORMAT:

Championship Rounds – 36 holes of individual stroke play

Divisions – Amateur can compete in one of five divisions

In the championship round, players are required to play in the same division in which they qualified in.

DAC Qualifier #3 – Saturday, June 22, 2019, Deadline: June 18, 2019 at 3:00 pm

DAC Qualifier #4 – Sunday, June 30, 2019, Deadline: June 26, 2019 at 3:00 pm

DAC Qualifier #5 – Saturday, July 6, 2019, Deadline: July 2, 2019 at 3:00 pm

Pairings and Tee Times

Pairings and tee times will be emailed to all players by Cedar Crest Golf Course. Pairings and tee times will be emailed 3 days prior to qualifier and available at iamagolfer.com by 5:00 p.m.

Transportation Policy

Contestants will have the option to ride during the qualifying rounds and championship rounds, however, caddies will be required to walk. Push carts will be allowed during the event.

Measuring Devices Permitted

A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

If you are uncertain about the legality of your distance measuring device, please consult a Rules Committee Member to verify the distance measuring device you are using is permitted.

Groove Regulations

The new USGA Groove Regulations **will not be in effect** for the Dallas Amateur Championship.

Dress Code

Proper golf attire is required during the Dallas Amateur Championship. and any applicable practice rounds. Contestants shall present a neat appearance, appropriate to the game of golf, in both clothing and grooming. Denim clothing shall not be worn at the host facility. Shorts and sleeveless and/or collarless shirts are considered appropriate attire.

All caddies are required to wear long pants or knee-length tailored shorts, and a collared shirt while at the host facility. Denim clothing, T-shirts, or shirts without collars shall not be worn. Caddies shall present a neat appearance in both clothing and personal grooming. Caddies shall wear smooth rubber- sole shoes preferably tennis or basketball shoes (golf spikes are not permitted).

Practice Rounds

Practice Rounds for Cedar Crest Golf Course may be booked up to 7 days of in advance. Practice Rounds for the Championship will be provided via email to qualified participants.
